Our Healing and Deliverance meetings are led by Pastor Marion Daniel, along with her family and team. The ministry has been established since 1983 and is a registered charity. Most team members have become involved in the vision of Sozo because they have been healed, or a family member or friend has been healed through the ministry.

We are an established ministry within the body of Christ with a vision for healing, miracles, deliverance and victorious living. Our vision is, "to bring wholeness to the world through Jesus." We are here to serve you and serve the church.

Many people who attend our monthly meetings are also attached to local churches and join us throughout the year for additional teaching, ministry and fellowship.

We also minister at other churches and fellowships when invited. If you are travelling for the first time to come and see us or if you are a regular, you are very welcome. Alongside the monthly Healing and Deliverance meetings, we also meet weekly as a fellowship and you are welcome to join us then too.

## HELPFUL INFORMATION FOR YOUR VISIT

### ARRIVAL

Drive through the pillars at the end of our drive and you will see our car park on the left. For larger meetings, stewards will be on duty to allow us to maximise our parking.

### THE MEETING

For our monthly Healing and Deliverance meetings, we open at 12:00pm. Guests can enjoy a hot drink or find a table if they have brought some lunch. Our bookshop will also be open. We appreciate people arriving a little early and being settled and ready to worship at 1:00pm. We ask everyone to enter into the presence of God silently as they come through the sanctuary doors, and get "caught up" in praise and worship. The service finishes after a prayer line at approximately 4:00pm.

### FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS

From midday, we serve hot and cold drinks in the Oak Barn. This ends at 12:50pm so that we can be ready to worship at 1:00pm. There is water available in the Sanctuary, please help yourself. Immediately after the service, refreshments are available. If you plan to stay on for prayer or fellowship, please bring packed food with you. Tables and chairs are available to sit at. There are no local shops in walking distance.

## PRAYER (available to people who attend the 1pm meeting)

We are in faith that your needs will be met through the service so please respond to all the ministry offered. If you decide after the meeting that you would still like personal prayer, please go to the stage area after the service to see the prayer coordinator, (around 4:30pm). We appreciate that most people want to be seen as early as possible, but we use our discretion over timing of appointments and endeavour to help the weak first. People who we have prayed with on a Sunday can also return for follow-up prayer at one of our Care and Prayer days. Please simply ask for more information.



## BOOKSHOP

There is an extensive range of books, CDs and DVDs available, the majority of which are not available from mainstream Christian bookshops. The message of the day is available at the bookshop immediately after the service on either DVD or CD. The Sozo Media Catalogue will help you choose which messages are particularly suitable for you. We also have 'Message of the Month', a service where we post out each message to your home if you are unable to be with us. Details are in reception. ## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Our Faith School is called 'Abraham's Children' for 4-11yrs, overseen by Emma Daniel. The children are encouraged to meet up with each other for the time of praise and worship. During the preaching of the Word, the children go out with the leaders for their own time with God. Do ask a steward to introduce you to Emma early so that your children can join the other children if they wish.

**Crèche:** We have an unmanned creche room for parents to use complete with toys. The service is streamed live on TV so parents do not miss anything. Please ask a steward for information.

**After Sozo Club:** From 5:00pm - 6:30pm we have fun, games and craft activities with leaders for your children to enjoy if you wish to stay on for prayer or fellowship. Please ask a steward.

**Parents:** Please make sure your children are not left unattended at any time. Please also remember to collect them promptly from the groups and activities.

**Child Protection:** We have a Church Child Protection Policy and dedicated co-ordinator to safeguard the well-being of all children that attend.

## AFTER SERVICE FELLOWSHIP

Get to know others from all over England and fellowship over tea! Stay to share, pray and encourage one another. The day ends at 7pm.

## DISABILITIES

We have level access throughout the building for wheelchair users, as well as disabled toilet facilities. We have an infra-red loop system which you can use if you are hard of hearing (please go to the sound desk). If you have any special needs, you may like to contact the office prior to the day. Please bring a carer if you need one and please feel free to bring something comfortable

## HOW TO FIND US

### Our address:

DUNWOOD OAKS CENTRE, DANES ROAD, AWBRIDGE, NR. ROMSEY, HAMPSHIRE **SO51 0GF**



Romsey is located off the M27 at either junction 2 or 3 near to the end of the M3. Romsey is north-west of Southampton and south of Winchester.

### Approaching from Romsey direction:

Take the A27 out of Romsey, following signposts for Salisbury (A36) by the Cromwell Arms Pub and Mainstone Veterinary Practice. Go up the hill and follow this road for 2 miles. You will pass the 'Blue Hayes' restaurant and a garage on your right. At the crossroads, turn right into DANES ROAD following signposts for AWBRIDGE and DUNWOOD OAKS CENTRE. Follow this road for exactly 0.5 miles then turn left down our track. This track leads down to our car park. At the end of the track, turn left through the brick pillars and our car park is in front of you.

### Approaching from Salisbury direction:

If approaching Dunwood Oaks from Salisbury on the A27, look out for a road sign on the left as you climb a small hill saying DUNWOOD OAKS CENTRE. Turn left into Danes Road and follow directions above.

### Connections:

Romsey has a railway station with good links to London and Southampton Airport. The airport has flights all over the UK and into Europe. Flybe is the principal carrier.
